


Edmunds 2018 New Car Sales Forecast: 16.8M


2018 is Off to a Strong – But Inconsistent – Start



2018 sales through May are up by 1.1% compared to the same time period in 2017, however, month-over-month fluctuations are enough to give pause




Strong Production, Record Incentives Bolster Sales



Days-to-Turn as of May 2018 highest since 2009




OEMs Find the Right Mix: Inventory Aligns with What Buyers Want

Strong Economy Gives Auto Industry a Boost




Unemployment hit 3.8% this year, the lowest rate since 2000




In May, auto loan interest rates averaged 5.75%, hitting a nine-year high






Cars Reinvent Themselves as SUVs

Rising Gas Prices Aren't Deterring SUV Shoppers






Cars Hit Record Low Segment Share

Déjà vu: Are We Setting Up for a Repeat of 2008?








Green Cars Still on Record Pace


